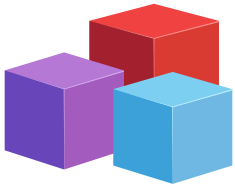

# 6 SYLLABLE TYPES



SYLLABLE TYPE	EXAMPLES	DEFINITION
<b>Open</b>	hotel ( <b>ho</b> •tel) maple ( <b>ma</b> •ple) retract ( <b>re</b> •tract)	<b>A syllable that:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• has one vowel</li> <li>• the vowel has a long sound</li> <li>• the vowel sound is the last sound</li> </ul>
<b>Closed</b>	( <b>cat</b> ) ( <b>dot</b> ) welcome ( <b>wel</b> •come)	<b>A syllable that:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• has one vowel</li> <li>• the vowel has a short sound</li> <li>• ends with a consonant</li> </ul>
<b>Silent E / VCe</b> (Vowel-Consonant-e)	( <b>spoke</b> ) compete (com• <b>pete</b> ) despite (de• <b>spite</b> )	<b>A syllable that:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ends with a silent “e”</li> <li>• has a consonant just before the silent “e”</li> <li>• has a previous vowel with a long sound</li> </ul>
<b>R-controlled</b> (Vowel-r)	( <b>star</b> ) resort (re• <b>sort</b> ) portable ( <b>por</b> • <b>ta</b> • <b>ble</b> )	<b>A syllable that:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• has at least one “r”</li> <li>• has a vowel just before an “r”</li> </ul>
<b>Vowel Team</b> (includes diphthongs - <i>ou, ow, oi, oy</i> )	( <b>you</b> ) ( <b>boat</b> ) meaning ( <b>mean</b> •ing)	<b>A syllable that:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• multiple vowels combine to make one sound</li> <li>• the vowel sound can be long or short</li> </ul>
<b>Consonant-le</b> (c-le)	table ( <b>ta</b> • <b>ble</b> ) cycle (cy• <b>cle</b> ) portable (port• <b>a</b> • <b>ble</b> )	<b>A syllable that:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• has no vowel sound</li> <li>• ends with -le (silent e)</li> <li>• has a consonant immediately before -le</li> </ul>
