

# Conjugating Progressive Verb Tenses

<b>Root Verb</b>	<b>Present Progressive Tense (am/is/are + -ing)</b>	<b>Past Progressive Tense (was/were + -ing)</b>	<b>Future Progressive Tense (will be + -ing)</b>
<b>bake</b>	I am baking a cake.	I was baking a cake.	I will be baking a cake.
<b>drink</b>	You are drinking juice.	You were drinking juice.	You will be drinking juice.
<b>feel</b>	Eve is feeling happy.	Eve was feeling happy.	Eve will be feeling happy.
<b>go</b>	We are going to Hawaii.	We were going to Hawaii.	We will be going to Hawaii.
<b>jump</b>	They are jumping on the bed.	They were jumping on the bed.	They will be jumping on the bed.
<b>kick</b>	I am kicking the ball.	I was kicking the ball.	I will be kicking the ball.
<b>make</b>	You are making a mess.	You were making a mess.	You will be making a mess.
<b>play</b>	Paul is playing with cars.	Paul was playing with cars.	Paul will be playing with cars.
<b>walk</b>	We are walking to school.	We were walking to school.	We will be walking to school.
<b>visit</b>	They are visiting from Peru.	They were visiting from Peru.	They will be visiting from Peru.
