

Types of Nouns + Examples

Proper Noun

A specific person, place, thing, or idea

Example: Disneyland

Common Noun

A general person, place, thing, or idea

Example: park

Singular Noun

Exactly one of a noun

Example: puppy

Plural Noun

More than one of a noun

Example: flowers

Compound Noun

Two or more words that create one noun

Example: toothpaste

Countable Noun

Can be counted

Example: book

Uncountable Noun

Cannot be counted

Example: sand

Concrete Noun

Can be seen, felt, heard, smelled, or tasted

Example: salt

Abstract Noun

Cannot be seen, felt, heard, smelled, or tasted

Example: freedom

Possessive Noun

A noun that owns something

Example: country's

Collective Noun

A group of things

Example: family
