

Types of Prepositions + Examples

Simple Preposition:

one word that connects nouns and pronouns in a sentence

Example: He sat on the chair.

Double Preposition:

two prepositions used together, often indicating direction

Example: The baby climbed onto the table.

Compound Preposition:

a compound word made of a simple preposition and another part of speech

Example: We were in the middle of the storm.

Participle Preposition:

a verb that functions like a preposition

Example: He works one job during the day.

Prepositional Phrase:

a group of words that includes a preposition, an object, and the object's modifier

Example: We hiked through the forest.
