bake	baking	She <i>is</i> baking for the sale.	She <i>was</i> baking when he arrived.	She <i>will be</i> baking all night.
cry	crying	He <i>is</i> crying for his mom.	He <i>was</i> crying all night.	He <i>will be</i> crying all night.
drink	drinking	They <i>were</i> drinking sodas.	What <i>were</i> you drinking today?	He <i>will be</i> drinking all day.
finish	finishing	He <i>was</i> busy finishing the job.	He <i>was</i> finishing until the end.	In an hour I <i>will be</i> finishing.
go	going	They <i>were</i> going to school.	They <i>were</i> going until the recess.	They <i>will be</i> going all day.
hit	hitting	He <i>was</i> hitting his brother.	He <i>was</i> hitting until she came.	He <i>will be</i> hitting all afternoon.
jump	jumping	She <i>was</i> jumping rope.	She <i>was</i> jumping all morning.	She <i>will be</i> jumping all day.
kick	kicking	They <i>were</i> kicking the ball.	Who <i>were</i> you kicking?	They <i>will be</i> kicking all day.
look	looking	We <i>were</i> all looking at him.	Who <i>were</i> you looking at?	We <i>will be</i> looking all night.
make	making	She <i>is</i> making dinner.	She <i>was</i> making trouble all day.	She <i>will be</i> making trouble.
open	opening	He <i>was</i> opening the box.	He <i>was</i> opening boxes all night.	He <i>will be</i> opening boxes.
pour	pouring	The rain <i>was</i> pouring.	What <i>was</i> he pouring all day?	He <i>will be</i> pouring all night.
rain	raining	It <i>is</i> raining outside.	How hard <i>was</i> it raining today?	It <i>will be</i> raining all night.
save	saving	He <i>was</i> saving his allowance.	He <i>was</i> saving his whole life.	He <i>will be</i> saving for years.
suffer	suffering	I <i>was</i> suffering from anxiety.	Who <i>was</i> suffering all day?	I <i>will be</i> suffering for years.
test	testing	She <i>was</i> testing his knowledge.	She <i>was</i> testing all day.	She <i>will be</i> testing all week.
visit	visiting	They <i>were</i> visiting for fun.	They <i>were</i> visiting all day.	They <i>will be</i> visiting all week.
walk	walking	He <i>was</i> walking for exercise.	He <i>was</i> walking every morning.	He <i>will be</i> walking all week.
wave	waving	They <i>were</i> waving hello.	They <i>were</i> waving all day.	They <i>will be</i> waving all week.
wear	wearing	He <i>was</i> wearing a red shirt.	He <i>was</i> wearing it last night	I <i>will be</i> wearing it tomorrow.
