# Subject-Verb Agreement Worksheet - Answers

1. She walks to the market.

The verb *walk* should be the singular *walks* to match with the singular subject *she*.

2. Of all the girls in this room, she is the most beautiful.

The verb *are* should be the singular form *is* to match with the singular subject *she*.

3. The cat meows when he is hungry.

The sentence is correct. The subject *cat* and the verb *meows* are both singular.

4. My favorite book is *Green Eggs and Ham*.

Even though *Green Eggs and Ham* is technically plural, it is a book title. Since we are talking about one particular book, you need to use the singular verb *is* instead of the plural verb *are*.

5. All of the leaves are falling off the trees.

This sentence is correct. The verb *are* matches the plural subject *leaves*.

6. Ten minutes is enough time to get there.

When expressing measurements of time, the verb should be singular. Use *is* instead of *are*.

7. The man and the woman were late for their appointment.

The sentence is correct. The two subjects are joined by *and*, so the plural verb *were* is correct.

8. One of the earliest things I remember is my third birthday.

Although *things* is plural, *one* is actually the subject. It should have a singular verb of *is*.

9. All of them are going to the parade.

*Them* is a plural pronoun. The verb for plural pronouns should be plural. Use the plural verb *are* instead of *is*.

10. One of the real problems is a lack of oversight.

Even though *problems* is plural, *one* is the singular subject. Use the singular verb *is*.
