1850

1st National Women's Rights Convention held

1866

American Equal Rights Association founded

15th Amendment passed

1869

15th Amendment ratified;
Black voting rights

1870

Susan B. Anthony arrested
for voting illegally

1872

Declaration of the Rights of
Women made public

1876

1890

National American Woman
Suffrage Association formed

1911

National Association Opposed to
Woman Suffrage formed

1917

National Woman's Party protest
at White House

1918

President Wilson champions
women's suffrage

19th Amendment passed

1919

19th Amendment ratified;
women's voting rights

1920
